

MONACO INTERNATIONAL MARDI GRAS IN MOULTRIE



Calling all Chili cooks and connoisseurs.....We are

having the first ever Monaco International Chili Cook-off in Moultrie. You can enter as an individual or as a team. We encourage individual Monaco clubs to put together teams to compete. The Cook-off rules are in this

newsletter, and will be posted on the web site.

Each entrant will be provided space with a 6 foot table and electricity. You provide your own cooking equipment, and any decorations, signs etc. to advertise the name of your chili or team.

We have a panel of experienced, unbiased judges. Here are the general attributes or characteristics of traditional red chili that each judge will be evaluating.

TASTE - Taste, above all else is the most important factor. The taste should consist of the combination of the meat, peppers, spices, etc, with no particular ingredient being dominant, but rather a blend of the flavors.

CONSISTENCY- Chili must have a good ratio between sauce and meat. It should not be dry, watery, grainy, lumpy, or greasy.


AROMA - Chili should smell good. This also indicates what is in store when you taste it.

COLOR - Chili should look appetizing. Reddish brown is generally accepted as good. Chili is not yellow or green.

BITE - Bite or after taste is the heat created by the various type of chili peppers and chili spices.

PRESENTATION - We're looking for the total of all the attributes and characteristics presented in a way that screams "I'm the winner."

OFFICIAL CHILI COOK-OFF RULES

Cook-off participants may choose to enter Traditional Red Chili or Chili Verde for judging.

Traditional Red Chili is any kind of meat or combination of meats, cooked with red chili peppers, various spices and other ingredients. **BEANS and PASTA are strictly forbidden**.

Chili Verde is kind of meat or combination of meats, cooked with green chili peppers, various spices and other ingredients. BEANS and PASTA are strictly forbidden.

- 1. No ingredient may be pre-cooked prior to the start of the official cook-off. The only exceptions are canned or bottled tomatoes, tomato sauce, peppers, pepper sauce, beverages, broth and grinding and/or mixing of spices. Meat may be treated, pre-cut or ground. MEAT MAY NOT BE PRE-COOKED, in any manner. All other ingredients must be chopped or prepared during the preparation period.
- 2. The cooking period will be 3 hours. Cooking will begin at 9:30 and end at 12:30. Your chili must be at the judges table no later than 12:30 to be judged. Cooking during entire cooking period is at the sole discretion of the contestant.
- 3. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own cooking utensils, etc. Monaco International will provide an area with power and a 6 foot table for each contestant.
- 4. Each contestant must cook a minimum of two quarts of competition chili prepared in one pot.
- 5. Each contestant will be assigned number and be given a 32 oz. judging cup. Each contestant should verify the number on the bottom of their cup is the same as their assigned contestant number.
- 6. Each contestant is responsible for delivering their cup to the judging area by 12:30 for judging. The cup must be filled at least three quarters full with your competition chili. Winners will be announced at dinner that evening.
- 7. If contestants wish they may also prepare a People's Choice Chili. It is each contestant's option if they want to participate in People's Choice. PEOPLE'S CHOICE CHILI MUST HAVE BEANS OR PASTA.




